This funding will be used to


- Improve students reading skills.
- Students will be tested every 2-3 weeks and the data tracked, and aligned, with the 'Whole School Reading Program' to ensure that every student is improving.
- Our target is that 90% of students are reading one year above their reading age by the end of the school year.

Our initiatives include

- Develop a whole school reading program based on the 'Daily Five' & 'Café Reading' programs.
- Weekly conversations including individual and small group instruction.
- Student centered goal setting around the skills students still need to acquire to move forward with their reading.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- On going development of a 'Whole School Reading Program'.
- A teacher's aide will be purchased for one day a week utilising the I4S funding. (The resultant funding shortfall to be met out of school allocated funds.)
- The aide will conduct regular weekly testing and prepare resources required for the teachers to successfully run our Whole School Reading Program.
